## Music Performance (24-26)

Major ensemble requirement (8 minimum) - Participation in a major ensemble every semester prior to student teaching. For all but two of those semesters students must participate in an ensemble most appropriate for their performing medium (i.e., winds and percussion performers in a concert band, string performers in an orchestra, vocalists in a choir), as designated by the College of Music. For two semesters students may elect to take any other auditioned ensemble (e.g., instrumentalists may take choir) to satisfy this requirement.
