REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH THE I-20 REQUEST:

- PASSPORT:** Copy of the passport bio page for student and dependents (if any)
- PROOF OF FUNDING:** Bank letter from you or your sponsor detailing a balance that equals or exceed the **MINIMUM FUNDING REQUIREMENTS FOR ISSUANCE OF I-20**
- AFFIDAVIT OF SUPPORT:** If sponsored by a person other than student: Complete the [Affidavit of Support form](#)
- SCHOLARSHIP LETTER (IF ANY):** If you are awarded a scholarship from MSU, provide your scholarship letter
- DEPENDENTS:** Provide copy of the passport page for each dependent.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

International Students with an F-1 immigration status must follow immigration regulations as outlined by the US government in order to maintain their immigration status.

These requirements include full-time enrollment during fall/spring semesters and first/final semesters.

Additionally, online course enrollment is restricted for F-1 students. F-1 students can count a maximum of one ONLINE course (the course must be 3 credits or less) toward their full-time enrollment requirements during fall/spring semesters and first/final semesters.

F-1 students must not participate in any off-campus employment without prior authorization from OISS. OISS is required to terminate immigration records of students who violate their immigration status.
